MEMORANDUM TO: Users of 1401 Autocoder System

SUBJECT: 1401 Autocoder System, Program #1401-AU-037,  
Version 3, Modification Level 10

This modification letter has been prepared for distribution to all users of the 1401 Autocoder System and contains changes to Version 3, Modification Level 9 of that system. These change cards, enclosed, listed and identified below (Attachment #1) are to be inserted in the system deck as follows:

Card Number (Cols. 72-75)	Place between cards in system deck

C101-C104	0115-0116
C105-C106	C090-0176
C107	C037-0969

Cards C101-106 provide for better noise checking in Pass 1.

Card C107 insures proper assignment of addresses following blank ORG's when an iteration takes place.

The following minor restriction or limitation is presently in effect with regard to the use of 1401 Autocoder when coding macro instructions:

@'s may not be used in parameters which govern the inclusion of entries which are alphameric DC's, DCW's, or literals through the use of substitution codes of the form )0A through )9I in the comments field.
